

**Resolution Number 76 amended**

**WHEREAS**, the St. Louis Development Corporation (SLDC) is an umbrella not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 355 of the Missouri Revised Statutes with the mission of fostering economic development and growth in the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the SLDC should submit to a one week furlough just like the other city employees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen sees SLDC as an extension of the city and it is a direct political subdivision of the city along with planning for the city; and

**WHEREAS**, SLDC should be required to contribute to the critical fiscal crisis confronting the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the revenues generated from the furlough should be directed to the City's General Revenue stream.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to call upon the St. Louis Development Corporation (SLDC) of the City of St. Louis to participate in a two week furlough as have the other city employees and the revenue generated should be directed to the City's General Revenue.
