WHEREAS, Officer Brown joined the police department in March, 2006 as a Recruit in training, graduated from the Policy Academy on November 2, 2006 and was assigned to the Seventh District; and

WHEREAS, Officer Brown achieved many accolades at the age of 22 and in his short time on the force; He had earned great respect from the force; On June 19, 2007 Chief Mokwa gave Officer Brown and Offficer Ehnes a Chief's Letter of Commendation award for their work in rescuing four customers in a robbery where a masked gunman held the victims hostage; Officer Brown was a coach of the Police Athletic League; and

WHEREAS, Officer Brown was a very positive person; He never quit on a play; He worked in the Community; He lived in the Community, He mentored and worked with kids and the kids loved him; and
