Alberta Marie Everette Douglas-Gantt

WHEREAS, we pause in our deliberations to note the untimely passing of St. Louis resident, Alberta Marie Everette Douglas-Gantt; and

WHEREAS, Alberta Marie Douglas-Gantt was a resident of the 1st Ward of the City of St. Louis for more than 50 years; and

WHEREAS, Alberta Douglas-Gantt served the St. Louis Public Schools for more than 50 years as a vocal music teacher and supervisor; and

WHEREAS, Alberta Douglas-Gantt served young women in the community at the Phyllis Wheatley YWCA in the capacity as president and member of the Administrative Committee for more than 35 years; and

WHEREAS, Alberta Douglas-Gantt was president of the National Association of University Women; and

WHEREAS, Alberta Douglas-Gantt was recognized by the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education as a pioneer; and

WHEREAS Alberta Douglas-Gantt was recognized by Gamma Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority for being the only member to have held membership for more than 75 years; and

WHEREAS Alberta Douglas-Gantt was a member of Union Memorial Methodist Church in the City of St. Louis

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause to remember the many contributions of Alberta Marie Everette Douglas-Gantt to the citizens of the City of St. Louis and we join with her many friends in expressing our sorrow at her passing, and we further direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to prepare a memorial copy for presentation to the Gantt family, at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
