WHEREAS, we have been apprised that Brian Travers will be recognized by the residents of the Twenty-Second Ward with the presentation of the Good Neighbor Award; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Travers was born and reared in St. Louis, has been married 21 years and is the proud father of two daughters; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Travers is a community business man of the 22nd Ward; serving as a community developer the past ten years, with his office located at 4427 Geraldine; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Travers' construction projects have created over 125 jobs; and

WHEREAS, Project 15 start up businesses are 70% minority owned; and

WHEREAS, all buildings he buys and owns are located in the City of St. Louis; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Travers' most notable project is 5101-5105 Farlin Avenue that sat vacant for 10 years and cost \$1.6 million environmental clean up, and \$2.1 million to renovate.
