Bishop Samuel White

WHEREAS, Bishop Samuel White has served Christendom within the Church of God in Christ for more than thirty-six years. During this time, he served as an Ordained Elder, a Junior Pastor, District Superintendent, and Chairman of the Board of Superintendents. He also served as Jurisdictional Comptroller, Chairman of the Budget Committee, Chairman of Finance, Souvenir Booklet Chairman and an organizer of Church Systems and Functions. He has also served as a member of the Church of God in Christ's National Constitution Committee; and

WHEREAS, Bishop White wrote the Financial Plan for Districts and Jurisdictions, which was adopted by the national church. He was a contributor of information written in the Jurisdictional Policy Procedural Manual, which was adopted by the General Board and the General Assembly of the Church of God in Christ. He was a contributor of information written in the book, "First Five Centuries of the Christian Church," by Dr. Donald Weeks; and

WHEREAS, Bishop White is the author of several books and pamphlets. He is a workshop facilitator, a financial consultant and the author of "Prudent Living in the 21st Century." He is the developer of widows of deceased clergymen and deceased community leaders across the states of Illinois, Arkansas, Missouri and Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Bishop White has served on many distinguished boards and committees. He served as the chairman for mentoring and tutoring the next generation of leaders; and

WHEREAS, for exemplary service, Bishop White has received many plaques and certificates too numerous to list. He is affiliated with many distinguished community organizations; and

WHEREAS, of all the accolades that could be given, Bishop White is most proud to called, 'Samuel, the Eternal God's Son.' He is the Pastor of Monroe Church and Heavenly Places Worldwide Ministries; and

WHEREAS, in July 2009, Bishop White was chosen to serve as Bishop of the Colleague of Bishops-the leaders of United Fellowship International Ministries, Inc.
