

RESOLUTION NUMBER 291
Detective Sergeant Stephen Clemons

WHEREAS, Detective Sergeant Stephen Clemons joined the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department as a police officer on April 17, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Detective Sergeant Clemons served in many units within the SLMPD, including the Sixth District, Area III Detectives, Mobile Reserve, Intelligence Unit and Crime Suppression Unit; and

WHEREAS, he was on duty in the Gang Unit when he was struck head-on by a vehicle which crossed the median. Detective Sergeant Clemons sustained a spinal injury and has not been able to return to full duty; and

WHEREAS, Detective Sergeant Clemons and his wife, Rhonda Clemons, have five children.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize Detective Sergeant Stephen Clemons and we direct the Clerk of this Board to spread a copy of this Resolution across the minutes of these proceedings and to further prepare a commemorative copy to the end that it may be presented to our honoree at a time and place deemed appropriate by the Sponsor.
