WHEREAS, in January, 1989 Sheriff James W. Murphy promoted Major Lynch to the rank of Major in charge of administration where he received numerous accolades including an award from the federal office of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms for a gun making system Major Lynch developed; and
