WHEREAS, we have been apprised that Police Officer Steven Schwerb DSN 5494 has been chosen as 2008 Police Officer of the Year for the First Police District; and

WHEREAS, throughout the term of his distinguished career, Officer Schwerb served as a Police Recruit in Training from November 1997 until his promotion to Probationary Patrol Officer in April of 1998 while being assigned to District Eight where he was promoted to Police Officer in October 1999.
