Stephen F. Meyerkord

WHEREAS, we have been apprised that Stephen F. Meyerkord will be receiving the Award of Honor which has been conferred annually by The Lawyers Association of St. Louis since 1946; and

WHEREAS, The Lawyers Association of St. Louis, in keeping with this custom, deems it appropriate that each year a tribute shall be paid to one member of the Bar of St. Louis whose attainments as a trial lawyer and whose record of honorable service to the profession and whose career as a citizen merit such recognition, not as a reward, but as an example that may inspire others to noble purpose and honorable effort in the profession of the law to which the members of The Lawyers Association of St. Louis have dedicated their lives; and

WHEREAS, Stephen F. Meyerkord graduated from Drury College, Springfield, Missouri earning an A.B. in Political Science with honors in 1970 and the Washington University School of Law, St. Louis, Missouri in 1974; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Meyerkord is a Partner with Meyerkord, Rineberg & Graham, LLC and previously was a Partner at Casey & Meyerkord, P.C.; and

WHEREAS, from 1979 to 1999, Mr. Meyerkord was a Paralegal Degree Program Instructor in Civil Trial Procedure and Torts and was designated as one of St. Louis Community College at Meramec's Outstanding Instructors in 1982, 1983 and 1984.

WHEREAS, Mr. Meyerkord is a member of The Missouri Bar, The Bar Association of Metropolitan St. Louis, The Association of Trial Lawyers of America, The Missouri Association of Trial Attorneys and The Lawyers Association of St. Louis. He previously served as president of The Missouri Association of Trial Attorneys and The Lawyers Association of St. Louis; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Meyerkord and his wife, Jane, have four children; Geoffrey, Amy, Andrew and Matthew.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Louis that we pause in our deliberations to recognize Stephen F.
